

Miscanthus 'Tiger Tail'

Key Features

- ✓ Unique stiff stems with masses of substance.
- ✓ Increased flower number.
- ✓ Attractive variegated banded foliage.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Miscanthus sinensis</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 21,788.
USDA Zone:	Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Flowerheads are silky bronze in color, drying to russet fall tones. Attractive if left uncut through the winter months.
Bloom Time:	July-October.
Foliage:	Attractive green foliage with bold variegated horizontal banding becoming stronger as temperatures increase.
Habit:	Tight clumping habit 5-7' x 3-4'.
Propagation:	Division & TC. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Fertile well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Controlled cross of M. 'Strictus' x M. 'Cosmopolitan'
Uses:	Garden border, modern courtyard, landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	8-12 weeks
2 Gallons:	12-16 weeks

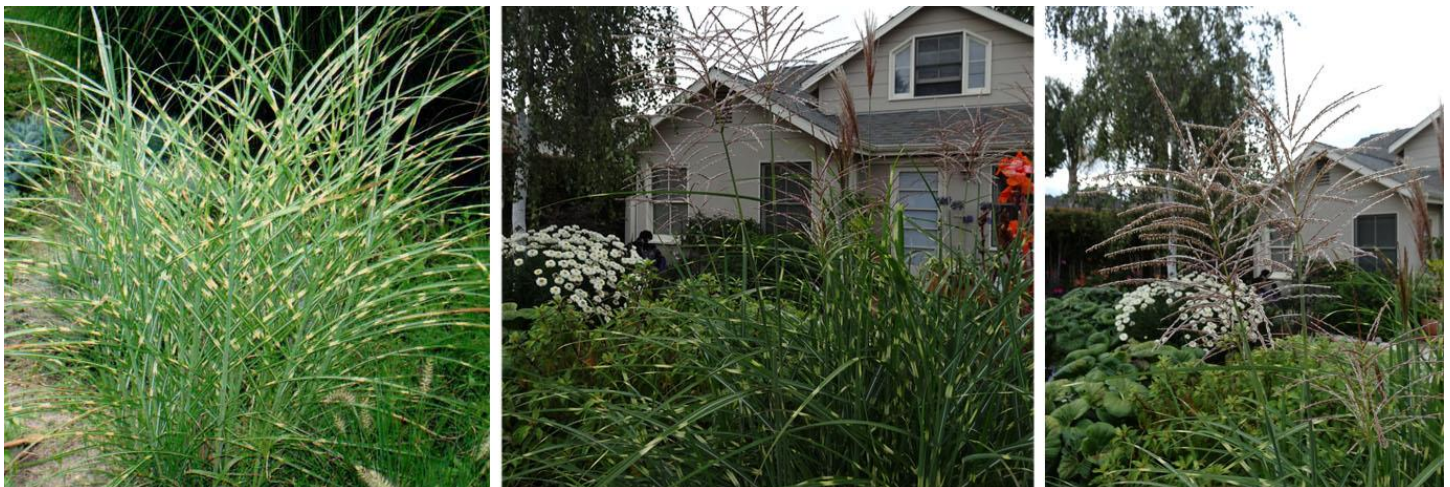
Closest Variety: M. 'Zebrinus'

Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Tiger Tail' upright-spreading habit **vs.** strongly upright habit.
- ✓ 'Tiger Tail' medium stems **vs.** stiff upright stems.
- ✓ 'Tiger Tail' average flowering **vs.** increased flower number.
