

## TALL DARK & HANDSOME® *Pelargonium Coral* = 'PEL14-06'

### Key Features

- ✓ Narrow upright columnar habit.
- ✓ Dark glossy black and green foliage.
- ✓ Flowering on the entire stem, not just the terminal shoots.



### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Pelargonium hybrid</i> (Code: VPPEL14-06)
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Estimated USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6.6°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Large coral flowers. Flowers formed along the entire stem, not just the terminal shoots.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	late spring – summer.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Dark glossy black and green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Very narrow columnar habit, 48" x 24".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Unique columnar habit, flowering on entire stem. Great for small yards and landscape applications.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, and landscape planting.
