Characteristics

Genus & Species:	Prunella <i>hybrid</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 19,609.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Showy flower spikes of vibrant pink hooded blooms.
Bloom Period:	Late spring – fall.
Foliage:	Mid green, oak leafed shaped foliage.
Habit:	Compact clump forming habit 10” x 10”.
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun - part shade, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Quick growing. A great development step forward in this neglected genus.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks

Comparison: P. ‘Freelander Blue’

- ✓ ‘Summer Daze’ vibrant pink blooms **vs.** violet-blue blooms.
- ✓ ‘Summer Daze’ compact habit **vs.** compact-medium habit.
- ✓ ‘Summer Daze’ oak leafed shaped foliage **vs.** regular foliage.
