<b>Habit:</b>	Tidy, small-medium, clumping habit. 12" x 12". Flower stem 36-48".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Easy care, grow in fertile soil in full sun to part shade. Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Specimen, perennial border, pots & containers.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>6-12 months</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>12-24 months</b>

- ✓ 'Alicia' broad variegated foliage **vs.** narrow variegated foliage.
- ✓ 'Alicia' large pure white flower **vs.** small sky blue flowers.
- ✓ 'Alicia' great impact **vs.** average.
