## **Characteristics**

Genus & Species:Cercis canadensisProtection Status:US Plant Patent 17,740.USDA Zone:USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

**Bloom:** Clusters of pink-lavender sweet pea like blooms borne on the bare stems in early spring.

**Bloom Time:** Early spring.

Foliage: Deciduous, golden yellow heart shaped foliage. New growth is blushed copper in color. Habit: Upright vase to spreading habit. 12' x 15'. The perfect tree for smaller sized yards.

**Propagation:** Budding / Grafting & Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.* **Culture:** Best grown in full sun to part shade in moist but well drained soils.

Additional Comments: Burn-resistant foliage even in full sun. Shaded foliage will turn chartreuse-green. Lightly trim as

required.

**Uses:** Garden specimen, hedging & landscape plantings.
