Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Colocasia esculenta</i> (Code: 12-2)
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 29,692.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 7b. (5°F or -14°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection. Spath/spadix inflorescence.
Foliage:	Medium dark glossy foliage with attractive contrasting light green veins and mid rib. Held on sturdy stems.
Habit:	Great multiple clumping habit. Ideal for premium gallon's, pots & containers. Ultimately 36' x 36'.
Propagation:	Tissue Culture / division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Moist rich well drained soil in full sun to part shade. 50°F nights and 70-80°F (or warmer) days.
Additional Comments:	This variety is the most robust of the Royal Hawaiian collection. It is being tested in Zone 6b to check its hardiness. Excess high nitrogen or drying out can cause foliage burn. Cut back after a month in a one gallon. More lateral shoots will emerge and the finishing time will be 4 weeks later. Other benefit of a cut back is stronger white marketing in the new emerging leaves.
Uses:	6" pots, containers, garden borders & mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	12-16 weeks
