Habit:	Compact rounded habit. No staking required. 31" x 24".
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, in rich moist well-drained medium.
Additional Comments:	Dead head spent flower to extend blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.
