## Characteristics

**Genus & Species:** Dahlia variabilis (Hort). **Protection Status:** US Plant Patent 20,954.

**USDA Zone:** USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C). Half hardy.

**Bloom:** Soft apricot, ribbed blooms with blush peach overtones & elegant dark centres.

**Bloom Period:** Early spring – fall.

Foliage: Fashionable mahogany to black foliage. Habit: Compact rounded habit 31" x 24".

**Propagation:** Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.* 

**Culture:** Full sun, in rich moist well-drained soil.

**Additional Comments:** Dead head spent flower to prolong blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

**Uses:** Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

## **Approximate Finishing Time**

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
