<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Spring. Repeating summer & fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Silver blue foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 11" x 11". Comparable habit to the Scent First® Tall Portfolio.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Well-drained soil in full sun. Trim back after summer blooming to encourage new growth & repeat fall blooming.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Improved disease resistance. A robust drought resistant perennial once established. Great for picking.
<b>Uses:</b>	Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape, long-lasting cut flower.
