### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Dianthus hybrida</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	US Plant Patent 24,363.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Early season highly scented double flowers. Unique coral colored flowers carried on sturdy stems. Repeat flowering.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Early season – Fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Blue silver foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 6" x 4".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting, cut flower.
