Bloom:	Masses of bright colorful double flowers, carried on sturdy stems.
Bloom Period:	Early season – Fall.
Foliage:	Blue silver foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 7” x 7”.
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting, cut flower.
