

STAR SINGLE™ Dianthus 'Neon Star'

Key Features

- ✓ Highly scented iridescent neon pink flower.
- **✓** Repeat flowering.
- ✓ Blue silver foliage.



Characteristics

Genus & Species:Dianthus hybridaProtection Status:US Plant Patent 14,549.USDA Zone:USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Masses of highly scented vivid neon pink flowers, carried on sturdy stems. Repeat flowering.

Bloom Period: Early season – Fall. **Foliage:** Blue silver foliage.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 7" x 7".

Propagation: Tip Cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed

and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.

Uses: Containers, borders, mass landscape planting, cut flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 8-10 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-16 weeks

Comparison: D. 'Kahori'

Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Neon Star' vivid neon pink flowers vs. lilac- pink flowers.
- ✓ 'Neon Star' blue silver foliage vs. green foliage.
- √ 'Neon Star' highly scented vs. no-average scent.
