### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Diascia hybrida</i> .
<b>Protection Status:</b>	EU Plant Breeders Right 27,456.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Large sterile coral flowers, giving masses of flowers over an extended season.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Long blooming period. Early spring– fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Small fresh green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact rounded habit. 10" x 12".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Excellent cool season crops. Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim back & feed to encourage strong re-blooming.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, baskets, borders, mass landscape planting.
