Bloom:	Bright sunshine yellow sweetly scented sterile flowers.
Bloom Period:	Early spring - summer. Exceptionally long flowering season.
Foliage:	Elegant cream & silver green variegated foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 18" x 24".
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to part shade, in fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Trim hard back in spring to encourage strong basal branching. A stable sport from the popular variety Fragrant Sunshine = 'Walfrasun'.
Uses:	Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.
