Characteristics

Bloom: Bright sunshine yellow sweetly scented sterile flowers. Bloom Period: Early spring - summer. (Long Flowering season).

Foliage: Deep green foliage.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 18" x 24".

Propagation: Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun to part shade, in fertile well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Trim hard back in spring to encourage strong basal branching.

Uses: Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 4-6 weeks 1 Gallon: 8-10 weeks

Closest Variety: E. 'Bowls Mauve'
