Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Euphorbia nicania x nicaeensis</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 14,868.
USDA Zone:	Zone 7. (0°F or -17°C).
Bloom:	Vivid yellow bracts in spring, lasting well into summer.
Bloom Time:	Early spring- summer.
Foliage:	Powder blue foliage, tips tinted pink in cooler temperatures. Dainty leaf size.
Habit:	Semi spreading rounded habit. 18” x 24”.
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Prune flowering stem hard back to the base after flowering to encourage strong new shoots.
Uses:	Beds, garden border, modern landscape plantings.

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
