

Geranium 'Cloud Nine'

Key Features

- ✓ Fully-double, duck egg blue flowers.
- Exceptionally long flowering period. Flowering continually in Europe from May-Sept.
- Robust habit, does not require staking.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Geranium pratense **Protection Status: EU PBR Pending**

Hardiness: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Fully-double, duck egg blue flowers up to 4cm in diameter.

Bloom Period: May - September.

Foliage: Attractive mid green heavily cut foliage. Habit: Vigorous in ground, compact in containers.

Propagation: Division / Tissue Culture. License will be required for propagation.

Culture: Full sun – partial shade, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Mildew resistant until end of season.

Uses: Beds, borders, landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 16-24 weeks

Comparison: G. Summer Skies

Key Differences: = 'Gernic' PP10,695

- ✓ 'Cloud Nine' average growing vs. strong faster growing.
- ✓ 'Cloud Nine' smaller flowers 2-3cm vs. large flower up to 4cm.
- ✓ 'Cloud Nine' flower mauve with pale center vs. flower duck egg blue.
