Propagation:	Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
2 Gallon:	14-16 weeks
