Genus & Species:	<i>Hypericum calycinum</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 26,400.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Elegant 1.5-2" sunshine yellow rose shaped blooms with masses of stamens.
Bloom Time:	Summer.
Foliage:	Evergreen. Lemon and lime variegated foliage. Blushed pink on new growth.
Habit:	Compact spreading habit. 8-12" x 24"
Propagation:	Semi-ripe cuttings / tissue culture / division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Easily grown in most locations. Best bloom & foliage color when grown in full sun in moist well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Underground runners make this a great low maintenance ground cover option.
Uses:	Container specimens, garden specimen, landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	6-12 months
2 Gallon:	14-16 months
