Genus & Species:	<i>Isotoma axillaris</i> (Code: LU13-01)
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 28,511.
USDA Zone:	Estimated USDA Zone 8. (10°F or -12°C).
Bloom:	Outrageous large flowers up to 1½" in size. Large five petalled flowers in an iridescent violet purple tone with cheery yellow eyes.
Bloom Period:	Summer-Fall. (Jul-Oct)
Foliage:	Cut feathery mid green leaves.
Habit:	Tidy compact rounded habit. 12" x 12".
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil. Trim back and feed after flowering to repeat in fall.
Additional Comments:	(Common Name: <i>Laurentia</i>). Nectar rich blooms, great for beneficial pollinating insects. Bred for long season of interest in patio pots & containers. Australian Native.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
