## **Characteristics**

**Genus & Species:** Isotoma axillaris (Code: LU14-01) **Protection Status:** US Plant Patent Applied For.

**USDA Zone:** Estimated USDA Zone 8. (10°F or -12°C).

**Bloom:** Outrageous large flowers up to 1½" in size. Large five petalled flowers in bold pink tones with

cheery yellow eyes.

Bloom Period: Summer-Fall. (Jul-Oct)

**Foliage:** Cut feathery mid green leaves.

**Habit:** Tidy compact rounded habit. 12" x 12".

**Propagation:** Softwood Cuttings. *License required for propagation.* 

**Culture:** Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil. Trim back and feed after flowering to

repeat in fall.

Additional Comments: (Common Name: Laurentia). Nectar rich blooms, great for beneficial pollinating insects. Bred for

long season of interest in patio pots & containers. Australian Native.

**Uses:** Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

## **Approximate Finishing Time**

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
