Bloom:	Vibrant violet blooms. High fragrance. Great for picking.
Bloom Time:	Early summer, trim back to repeat in fall.
Foliage:	Fragrant fresh grey green foliage.
Habit:	Tidy rounded habit. 18" x 18".
Propagation:	Tip cuttings / Tissue culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun. Trim back after flowering to encourage tidy new growth & repeat fall flowering.
Additional Comments:	Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Good stem length, great for picking. Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Pots & containers, garden border, hedging, modern landscape, long-lasting cut flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-14 weeks

Comparison: *L. 'Hidcote'*

Key Differences:

- ✓ **Violet Intrigue** vibrant violet flowers **vs.** paler purple.
- ✓ **Violet Intrigue** longer flowers stems **vs.** shorter flower stems.
- ✓ **Violet Intrigue** higher bud count **vs.** lower bud count.
