Characteristics

Genus & Species: Lomandra confertifolia spp. rubiginosa (Code: 'Losbl-2')

Protection Status: Rights Asserted. **USDA Zone:** 8-11. (10°F or -12°C).

Bloom: Caterpillar like blooms, on small stems, within the foliage.

Bloom Time: July-September.

Foliage: Elegant fine foliage in cool silver blue tones. Evergreen foliage weeping with maturity.

Habit: Tidy clumping habit, Foliage weeping with maturity. 12-24" x 12-36".

Propagation: Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Well drained soil with low to occasional irrigation. Great for raised planters or large containers to

allow foliage to weep. Cut foliage back in spring to encourage fresh re-growth.

Uses: Container specimen well drained perennial border, well-drained mass landscape planting.
