

Lysimachia ‘Midnight Sun’

Key Features

- ✓ Lush plum to black foliage.
- ✓ Attractive sunshine yellow flowers.
- ✓ Compact prostrate to trailing growth habit.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Lysimachia congestiflora</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 22,242.
USDA Zone:	Estimated USDA Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).
Bloom:	Attractive star shaped sunshine yellow flowers.
Bloom Period:	Blooming from early summer for a long period.
Foliage:	Lush dark plum to black foliage with plum stems.
Habit:	Compact prostrate to trailing growth habit. 2-4" x 12-24". Freely branching.
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Happy in full sun to part shade.
Additional Comments:	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching. Good garden performance.
Uses:	Hanging containers, ground cover for borders or mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-14 weeks

Comparison: *L. nummularis* ‘Aurea’

Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Midnight Sun’ dark plum to black foliage **vs.** golden foliage.
- ✓ ‘Midnight Sun’ yellow flowers **vs.** yellow flowers.
- ✓ ‘Midnight Sun’ well branched **vs.** average branching.
