

Magnolia 'Genie'

Key Features

- ✓ Masses of unique deep plum-red blooms. (Significantly more than traditional soulangeana hybrids).
- Repeat summer blooming.
- \checkmark Tidy pyramidal habit 10' x 5' the perfect tree for smaller yards.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Magnolia soulangeana x liliflora 'Nigra'

Protection Status: US Plant Patent 20,748.

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Masses of deep plum-red blooms born on bare stems in early spring.

Bloom Time: Early spring-summer; repeat blooming mid/late summer where conditions are not

too dry.

Foliage: Deciduous small foliage, dark green in color, showing resistance to Magnolia Leaf Spot.

Habit: Tidy pyramidal habit with herringbone branch structure. 10' x 5'. **Propagation:** Budding / Grafting / Cuttings. License required for propagation.

Culture: Best grown in full sun in fertile well drained soils.

Additional Comments: The perfect tree for smaller sized yards. Irrigate well in summer / drought conditions.

Uses: Garden specimen, street trees, landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

- √ 'Genie' significantly more blooms vs. average bloom number.
- ✓ 'Genie' tidy pyramidal habit 10' x 6' vs. larger habit 20' x 10'.
- ✓ 'Genie' very stable bloom color vs. less stable esp. summer blooming.
