Habit:Tidy super dwarf habit. Maximum 2.5ft x 2ft.Propagation:Tip Cuttings. License required for propagation.Culture:Full sun – part shade, in moist fertile soil.

Additional Comments: 'Little Prince' is the shortest Banana available on the market compared to 'Dwarf Cavendish at 8-

10ft and 'Super Dwarf Cavendish' at 4-6ft.

Uses: Perfect tropical accent plant. Being a real thick-leafed banana, it is excellent when used as a wrap

for grilling meats. Great for containers, borders, landscape planting.
