Additional Comments:	'Little Prince' is the shortest Banana available on the market compared to 'Dwarf Cavendish' at 8-10ft and 'Super Dwarf Cavendish' at 4-6ft.
Uses:	Perfect tropical accent plant. Being a real thick-leafed banana, it is excellent when used as a wrap for grilling meats. Great for containers, borders, landscape planting.
