<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Long blooming period. Early spring– fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Small fresh green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tight compact rounded habit. 8" x 8".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Tip when young to encourage strong basal branching.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.
