Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Oenothera fremontii</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 19,663.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4-8. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Bright lemon yellow 2.5” blooms. Essentially seedles.
Bloom Period:	Late spring then re-blooming mid summer and early fall.
Foliage:	Remarkably narrow silvery foliage, greener in spring.
Habit:	Compact mat forming habit 10” x 18”.
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, in well draining soil.
Additional Comments:	Easy Care. Drought tolerant once established. Resistant to browsing deer and rabbits. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, borders, landscape planting.

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
