Bloom:	Large 2.5" pale pink blooms with yellow center. Essentially seedless.
Bloom Period:	Summer-fall.
Foliage:	Deep purple-bronze foliage with green leaf margins.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 12" x 12".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, in well-draining soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Easy Care. Great for attracting pollinating insects.
Uses:	Containers, borders, landscape planting.
