Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Passiflora</i> hybrid
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 29,608. EU PBR 48,160.
USDA Zone:	Zone 8b. (15°F or -9°C).
Bloom:	Striking large pure white flowers due to the polyploid vigor. Flowers are larger and longer lasting than regular hybrids. Blooms last for two or more days.
Bloom Time:	Spring. Repeat summer & fall.
Foliage:	Dark green leathery foliage.
Habit:	Vigorous and strong growing. Begins to flower on a very small plant.
Propagation:	Stem cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Plant in well-drained soil in full sun. Trim plants in spring to shape & encourage new growth.
Additional Comments:	Polyploid vigor confers improved disease resistance. Flowers significantly larger than <i>P. caerulea</i> see image below.
Uses:	Climber and large containers.

2 Gallon:	12-16 weeks
