### Key Features

### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Pennisetum alopecuroides</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	US Plant Patent 21,917.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Zone 6 (-5°F or -23°C). (Currently testing in Zone 5).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Foliage selection. Soft cream, bottle brush type seed heads produced in summer.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Mid-late summer.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Fine fresh green foliage highlighted by red accents in summer. The whole plant is truly blazing by fall.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tight clumping habit 18" x 18".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Fertile well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Sport of ‘Little Bunny’.
<b>Uses:</b>	Pots & containers, border, mass landscape plantings.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>1 Quart:</b>	<b>4-6 weeks</b>
<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b>
