Key Features

- ✓ Spikes of pure white tubular blooms.
- ✓ Obedient stems, which do not flop or need stacking.
- ✓ Drought tolerant once established.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Physostegia virginiana</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 12,637.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 3. (-40°F or -40C).
Bloom:	Spike of pure white tubular blooms.
Bloom Period:	Mid - late summer.
Foliage:	Darker green foliage.
Habit:	Compact clump forming habit 24" x 12".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings / Division / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – part shade, in moist fertile soil.
Additional Comments:	Easy Care.
Uses:	Containers, borders, landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks

Comparison: P. ‘Summer Snow’

Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Miss Manners’ compact habit **vs.** medium-large habit
- ✓ ‘Miss Manners’ no stacking necessary **vs.** best with stacking.
- ✓ ‘Miss Manners’ well behaved **vs.** no so well behaved.
