Characteristics

Genus & Species:Rosmarinus officinalisProtection Status:US Plant Patent 18,192.USDA Zone:Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).Bloom:Good dark blooms.Bloom Time:Early summer - fall.

Foliage: Mid green needle like foliage with high oil count. Great for cooking.

Habit: Tight bushy habit, upright to trialing in time. 12" x 12". **Propagation:** Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Well-drained soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Heat & drought tolerant once established.

Uses: Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern landscape.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks

Comparison: R. 'Lockwood de Forest'

Key Differences:

- √ 'Roman Beauty' tight bushy habit vs. more open habit.
- √ 'Roman Beauty' good vigor vs. slow-medium vigor.
- √ 'Roman Beauty' dark bloom color vs. paler blooms color.
