Bloom:	Large domed flower heads of unique cerise star shaped blooms.
Bloom Period:	Summer – fall.
Foliage:	Medium sized mid green foliage.
Habit:	Compact clump forming habit 12" x 12".
Propagation:	Semi ripe cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies. Dried flower heads are excellent for winter garden accents.
Uses:	Containers, borders, landscape planting, cut Flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
