Genus & Species:	<i>Styrax japonicus</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 24,168.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Fragrant pure white bell shaped blooms typical of the species.
Bloom Time:	Early spring-summer; repeat blooming mid/late summer where conditions are not too dry.
Foliage:	Deciduous, glossy dark purple foliage.
Habit:	Tight upright habit. 15' x 10' at full maturity
Propagation:	Budding / Grafting. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in full sun in fertile well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Currently trialing to confirm growth rate / persistence of foliage color.
Uses:	Garden specimen, landscape plantings, hedging.

5 Gallon:	2 years
15 Gallon:	3 years
