### Key Features

- ✓ Unique vigorous weeping habit. 6' x 5'.

### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Styrax japonicus</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	US Plant Patent 19,664.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Masses of strongly fragrant pure white blooms.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early spring-summer; repeat blooming mid/late summer where conditions are not too dry.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deciduous, glossy dark green foliage, coloring to golden yellow in fall.
<b>Habit:</b>	Vigorous weeping habit. 6' x 5'.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Budding / Grafting. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best grown in sun-part shade in fertile well drained soils.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	<b>Best in Show – Farwest 2008.</b> The perfect tree for smaller sized yards. Irrigate well in summer / drought conditions.
<b>Uses:</b>	Garden specimen, street trees, landscape plantings.

<b>5 Gallon:</b>	<b>2 years</b>
<b>15 Gallon:</b>	<b>3 years</b>

### Comparison: S. 'Carillion'

### Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Fragrant Fountain' significantly more blooms **vs.** average bloom.
- ✓ 'Fragrant Fountain' strong central leader **vs.** needs training.
- ✓ 'Fragrant Fountain' tolerant of extreme temperatures **vs.** less tolerant.
