Key Features

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Thuja occidentalis</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 21,967.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5-8. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection.
Bloom Time:	N/A.
Foliage:	Evergreen aromatic, bright yellow-gold foliage, year round.
Habit:	Tight upright pyramidal habit becoming conical with maturity. 8' x 4' in 10 years. (Ultimately 20' x 5' untrimmed).
Propagation:	Mature winter cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in full sun in moist well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Dislikes dry conditions – this may lead to foliage burn. Color holds well in winter temperatures. Sport from industry mainstay Thuja Emerald Green = 'Smaragd'.
Uses:	Container specimens, garden specimen, landscape plantings and hedging.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	12 months
2 Gallon:	12-18 months

Comparison: *T. Emerald Green*
= 'Smaragd'

Key Differences:

- ✓ '*Janed Gold*' golden foliage **vs.** mid green foliage.
- ✓ '*Janed Gold*' tight pyramidal habit **vs.** tight pyramidal habit.
- ✓ '*Janed Gold*' hold color well in winter **vs.** holds color well in winter.
