

Verbena 'Little One'

Key Features

- ✓ Compact genetic dwarf.
- ✓ Elegant hazy flower spikes of deep purple blooms.
- ✓ No seed observed in 3 years of trials.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Verbena bonariensis</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 18,124.
USDA Zone:	Zone 7-10. (0°F or -18°C).
Bloom:	Elegant hazy flower spikes of deep purple blooms.
Bloom Time:	Summer-fall. (Long Blooming Season)
Foliage:	Toothed mid green foliage.
Habit:	Tight bushy habit. 18" x 10". (Ultimately 2' x 18").
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.
Additional Comments:	Heat & drought tolerant once established. Trim back when young & after blooming to encourage strong basal branching & re-blooming.
Uses:	Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks

Comparison: *V. bonariensis*

Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Little One' 5' x 2' vs. 2' x 1'.
- ✓ 'Little One' freely seeds vs. no seed observed.
- ✓ 'Little One' average blooming season vs. long blooming season.
