Bloom Period:	Dripping with blooms from 8 weeks: May - June.
Foliage:	Lush spring green foliage.
Habit:	Tight compact rounded habit. 3' x 3'.
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
Additional Comments:	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	6-12 months.
2 Gallons:	12-18 months.
