

## TOWERS OF FLOWERS® *Weigela Cherry* = 'WG16-04'

### Key Features

- ✓ Narrow upright columnar habit.
- ✓ Large cherry red flowers. Flowers in clusters.
- ✓ Flowering on the entire stem, not just the terminal shoots.



### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Weigela x hybrida</i> (Code: VPWG16-04)
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Estimated USDA Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Large cherry red flowers. Flowers are formed in clusters and open all together along the entire stem, not just the terminal shoots.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Full bloom (3 weeks to 1 month) during late spring – partial bloom during summer.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Medium green leaves. Bronzing on new growth.
<b>Habit:</b>	Very narrow columnar habit, 48" x 24".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Unique columnar look, flowering on entire stem. Great for small yards and color in the landscape.
<b>Uses:</b>	Landscape specimen, Containers, and mass landscape planting.
