

WALBERTON'S® *Yucca Bright Star* = 'Walbrista'

Key Features

- ✓ Uniform bright golden variegated foliage.
- ✓ Mature clumps are topped with 3' spikes of pink buds opening to white bell shaped flowers.
- ✓ A striking impulse plant with a long period of seasonal interest.



Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Yucca gloriosa</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 17,653.
USDA Zone:	Zone 7. (5°F or -15°C).
Bloom:	3' spikes of pink buds opening to pure white bell-shaped blooms.
Bloom Time:	Mid-late summer.
Foliage:	Broad bright yellow variegated foliage. Coloring pink-red in the cooler months or in periods of high water stress.
Habit:	Tight clumping habit. 3' x 3'.
Propagation:	TC / Toe cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun to part shade.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Spikes are very sharp – position carefully. Sport from <i>Y. gloriosa</i> 'Variegata'.
Uses:	Low-maintenance Containers, Garden Border, Xeriscape landscapes.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	12-14 weeks
2 Gallon:	24-36 weeks

Comparison: *Y. 'Variegata'*

- ✓ **Bright Star** vigorous grow rate **vs.** average.
