## **Characteristics**

Genus & Species: Digitalis x valinii (D. purpurea x D. canariensis (Syn. Isoplexis canariensis)). (Code: DGI9)

**Protection Status:** US Plant Patent 25,442 USDA Zone: USDA Zone 8b. (15°F or -9°C).

**Bloom:** Sterile tropical bicolor flowers in attractive hot pink and white tones. Blooms continually for up to

5months.

**Bloom Period:** Re-blooming. May to September with cool night temperatures.

**Foliage:** Small to medium mid green leaves.

Habit:Clumping habit with narrow columnar flower spikes, 36"- x 24".Propagation:Tissue Culture & softwood cuttings. License required for propagation.Culture:Best with partial shade with moderately fertile well-drained soil.

**Additional Comments:** Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Remove spent flower stems and feed to encourage

re-blooming. Great for pollinator gardens. Ideal for bees and hummingbirds. Deer resistant.

**Uses:** Containers, perennial borders and mass landscape planting.
