### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Nemesia hybrida</i> . (Code: B22)
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	First saturated yellow & plum bicolor flowers. Break out the sunglasses. Large flowers. Highly scented. Sunshine yellow lower petals, contrast well with the saturated plum upper petals.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Long blooming season.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Small dark green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact rounded habit. Ideal for 4” pots, & early season containers & baskets. Ultimately 8” x 8”.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Pinch when young to encourage strong basal branching. <b>Full flower in Chicago in July.</b> Trim after flowering to encourage good habit a rapid re-flowering. Trim to re-flower in 3 in 4 weeks.
<b>Uses:</b>	4” pots, & early season containers, baskets, borders & mass landscape planting.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>1 Quart:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b>
<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks</b>
