Foliage:	Rich purple new foliage, flushing throughout the season maturing to dark green tones.
Habit:	Tidy compact rounded habit. 16" x 16".
Propagation:	Softwood Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, in rich moist well-drained medium.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies. Compact habit minimal trimming required. Ideal for pot culture.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.
