Bloom Period:	Mid summer to fall.
Foliage:	Fresh small to medium mid green leaves.
Habit:	Clumping habit. 12" x 12" at maturity.
Propagation:	Tissue Culture & softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best in full sun with moderately fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Great for pollinator gardens. Ideal for bees and hummingbirds.
Uses:	Containers, perennial borders and mass landscape planting.
