Bloom:	Bright cherry red flowers. Continuous blooming.
Bloom Period:	Early spring – fall.
Foliage:	Elegant small dark green foliage.
Habit:	Compact rounded habit 12" x 24". (Ultimately 24" x 36")
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, in warm garden position. Drought tolerant once established.
Additional Comments:	Loves the heat. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
