### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	Lamium <i>maculatum</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Spikes of soft pink colored blooms. Re-blooming in fall.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Spring - fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Silver foliage with fresh lemon yellow margin.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mat forming habit 4-6" x 12-18".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun – partial shade. Tolerant of most soils.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Easy care. Drought tolerant once established. Exhibits good resistance to leaf spots.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

<b>1 Quart:</b>	<b>4-6 weeks</b>
<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b>
