Characteristics

Genus & Species:	Lamium <i>maculatum</i> (Code: T4)
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Spikes of soft pink colored blooms. Re-blooming in fall.
Bloom Period:	Spring - fall.
Foliage:	Large attractive silver foliage with dark green margin.
Habit:	Compact mat forming habit 6-8" x 12-18".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade. Tolerant of most soils.
Additional Comments:	Easy care. Drought tolerant once established. Exhibits good resistance to leaf spots.
Uses:	Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	4-6 weeks
1 Gallon:	6-8 weeks

- ✓ ‘Orchid Frost Grande’ large flowers **vs.** medium flowers.
