## Characteristics

**Genus & Species:** Eryngium x zabelii **Protection Status:** Rights Asserted.

**USDA Zone:** Estimated USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).

**Bloom:** Large intense steel-blue deeply divided flower heads with very good blue stems.

Bloom Period:Blooming from early summer May - June.Foliage:Deeply divided silver green foliage.Habit:Sturdy upright clumping habit. 3' x 2'.

**Propagation:** Tissue Culture or Root Cuttings. *License required for propagation.* 

**Culture:** Happy in moderate-poor soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Great for cutting.

Uses: Garden borders, mass landscape planting. Great for cutting.

## **Approximate Finishing Time**

1 Gallon: 10-14 weeks 2 Gallon: 14-16 weeks

Comparison: E. x zabelii 'Big Blue'

- ✓ 'Blue Waves' Larger flower heads vs. medium.
- ✓ 'Blue Waves' deeply divided foliage vs. divided foliage.
- √ 'Blue Waves' very good blue stems vs. green stems.
